

## Return to School Quick Checker for Year Two

What I need to know	How will this look for my child and I?
How do I access the school site in the morning?	<p>Please enter the school site via the main gate at the front of the school.</p> <p>You must enter the site via the green EYFS gates if you have other children in EYFS or Year One.</p> <p>Follow the signs to the right of the school building to enter the back playground.</p> <p>If your child has no siblings, please go straight ahead at the main front gates and walk to the left of the school past the main office.</p> <p>All Year Two children must be dropped off at the hall doors.</p> <p>Please ensure you stand behind the red lines.</p>
What time do I need to arrive?	<p>Please don't arrive before 8:35am.</p> <p>Class teachers will open the doors from 8:40am until 9:10am</p>
What if my child becomes upset when I leave?	<p>We will ensure that transition into school is as smooth and calm as possible. Sometimes, your child may be less keen to come into the classroom. In this case, a member of staff will be there to support you.</p> <p>We will always call you after to reassure you that your child is doing ok.</p>
What should I do if we arrive late?	<p>If you arrive after 9:10am, you will need to bring your child to the main school office and sign them in on our online signing in system.</p>
What is expected of me as a parent when I am on the school site?	<p>We request that you enter and leave the school site as quickly as possible. Please don't stay on the playground to chat with friends as we need to keep the flow of families moving during drop off and pick up times.</p> <p>Please observe social distancing wherever possible.</p>
Will I need to wear a face covering when I drop my child off?	<p>You are welcome to wear a face covering when on the school site and <u>must</u> wear one if you enter the school building.</p> <p>At present, children are not required to wear face coverings.</p>
What should I do if I have a question or	<p>Please call the school office to pass on messages. The teacher will get back to you during the day.</p>

message for the teacher?	All urgent messages will take priority and you will be contacted by a member of our office team
Will my child be with the same friends as last year?	Yes, we are not mixing the classes up this year and the children will be with the same friends as they were last year.
What will my child need to bring with them?	You child will only need to bring a water bottle and a school book bag. Please <u>do not</u> bring large rucksack style bags. A PE kit must be kept in school.
Will the school provide my child with a lunch?	We provide a hot school meal every day. You are welcome to bring a packed lunch if you know your child won't eat the lunch option but we would prefer the school meal option if at all possible.
Can I leave the school site from the front entrance?	No. We will be running a 1 way system and everyone <b>MUST</b> leave from the back gate at the back of the school.
What time must I arrive at school at the end of the day?	Please don't arrive before 2:45pm. Teachers will open the classroom doors from 2:50pm until 3:10pm
What do I need to do if my child is unwell?	Please phone the school office on the morning of the first absence. If the absence is Covid-19 related, please follow the Covid Quick Checker.
