Please can we ask that all absences are made through the school office telephone number and not via email. The office team are not all in on the same day and its very important we hear about absences early in the school day.

Sickness A reminder that if your child has been sick or has diarrhoea they must stay away from school for at least 48 hours before returning back to school. When reporting your child absent from school, please ensure you call the school office before 9am on each day of their absence.
