


#### OUR OPEN DOOR POLICY

For our stalls, we would welcome donations of any chocolate treats. These could be cakes, chocolate biscuits, a box of chocolates, chocolate bars or even


Easter eggs. Please bring your donations into school from Monday 13th March. If you are going to be donating a homemade item, please read the important information below.


